

2007 MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD PAGEANT – US

Rules and Regulations

1. Each delegate must be at least 14 years of age and not older than 19 by the time of the **MISS TEEN WORLD US** National Pageant in July 2008.
2. Delegates must be born female, single, never married, nor given birth to a child. She must possess inner-beauty, intelligence, charm, be a successful role model for other teens, character above reproach, and maintain a professional demeanor.
3. Official Sponsorship Fee is **\$375.00**. If accepted, contestant must obtain at least one Full Page of Advertisement (**\$250.00**). Delegate is responsible for hotel accommodations, airfare or transport, entire wardrobe for competition, and any incurred expenses during the **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** event.
4. State Director has the right to cancel pageant if there are less than 10 qualified applicants. State Director will have the right to appoint a State Queen. State winner will be responsible for airfare and accommodations to and from the National **MISS TEEN WORLD US Pageant** if chosen at large.
5. All decisions of the judges are final.
6. Any contestant and/or family member or guest showing unsportsman-like behavior will not be tolerated and could result in an applicant's disqualification. No refunds will be given at this point.
7. If for any reason a winner is disqualified, or elects not to participate, her title and all awards will be passed on to the next choice of the judges.
8. The **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** reserves the right to change the date and location of the State pageant with very little notice.
9. Winner of the title **2008 MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** promises to promote the pageant by making a minimum of 6 personal appearances during her reign. Titleholders further promise to make no personal appearances or appear in any advertising and/or publications without permission from the State Director. **2008 MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** is contractually bound to return to the 2009 State Pageant to crown her successor.
10. Applicant may withdraw from the competition at any time. However, in doing so, she must return the state crown and banner to the State Director. Under no circumstances shall the applicant be entitled to a refund in whole or in part of any fees paid to **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US**. All fees paid to Miss Hawaii Teen World- US are NOT REFUNDABLE and NOT TRANSFERABLE in full or in part under any circumstances. This includes, but is not limited to all pageant fees, paid to **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** by anyone including, but not limited to, delegate fees, sponsorship fee, and advertisement.
11. State crowns and banners remain the property of the **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** Pageant until after the national competition. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable. Pageant disclaims liability for taxes, lost or stolen prizes or the action of the independent suppliers of the prizes. Any delegate who defaults on her contract must return all awards including crown and banner to the national office in the condition in which it was received and given to the first runner-up.
12. **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** reserves the right to modify or amend any rules and regulations, and qualifications at the sole discretion of the pageant authorities at any time.
15. Applicant hereby agrees that all audio, video and photographic recordings and or images made of my likeness during the performance of the 2007-2008 pageant, shall be released, for use by **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US**, and National/International Pageant and its directors and staff. I grant all rights exclusive to the **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** and National/International Pageant, to publish, reproduce,

exhibit, broadcast, televise, copyright, assign to use in any manner whatsoever including advertising and promotional use in print video or internet use, without further written or verbal consent or payment.

16. In the event that applicant is not able to fulfill the requirements as a delegate, applicant understands that she will not be able to participate in the 2008 pageant, all fees paid are non-refundable.
17. Delegate/parents agree to release, and forever hold harmless, and waive any and all claims against Miss Hawaii Teen World – US, its owners, The **MISS TEEN WORLD US** Organization, hotel/venue property, agents, volunteers, staffs, for property damage, injuries, losses, debts incurred arising from or occurring during any pageant related event even if said property damage injury, losses, debts incurred results from the negligent act or omissions, of the Directors, owners, volunteers, relatives, heirs, successors, and or assigns brings any legal action in violation of any of the agreed terms or provisions contained herein above, said contestants agree to fully indemnify and defend the **MISS HAWAII TEEN WORLD - US** Pageant, the National **MISS TEEN WORLD US** Pageant, its owners, agents, representatives, volunteers against said action.
